DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIONS
(Revision)

On November 2, 1965, THE JACKSON HOLE CORPORATION, INC., A Wyoming corporation, declared certain restrictions for the Aspen Highlands Addition of the Green Mountain Tract, the Plat thereof being filed as Plat Number 171 in the Office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds for Teton County, Wyoming, and the restrictions being filed for record on November 12, 1965, in Book 12 of Mixed Records at page 336 under reception number 87038.

A new Plat has been filed for the Aspen Highlands Addition as Plat Number 175 in the Office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds for Teton County, Wyoming, changing the description for this addition to read as follows, to-wit:

That part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, T. 41 N., R. 116 W., Teton County, Wyoming, described as follows:
 Beginning at a point that lies S. 01° 08' 40" E. a distance of 848.23 ft. from the B.L.M. Brass Cap monumenting the Center of Section 33, T. 41 N., R. 116 W., Teton County, Wyoming;
 thence S. 00° 08' 12" W. a distance of 433.02 feet to a point monumented by a typical property line mon.;
 thence S. 89° 34' 00" E. a distance of 1294.75 feet to a point monumented by a 3" P. Morton brass cap;
 thence N. 00° 55' 41" E. a distance of 471.85 feet to a point monumented by a typical boundary monument;
 thence N. 78° 26' 52" W. a distance of 306.73 feet to a point monumented by a typical boundary monument;
 thence N. 70° 00' 00" W. a distance of 402.69 feet to a point monumented by a typical boundary monument;
 thence following a curve to the left whose radius is 29.78 feet a distance of 26.35 feet to a point monumented by a typical boundary monument;
 thence following a curve to the left whose radius is 1412.40 feet a distance of 299.02 feet to a point monumented by a typical boundary monument;
 thence S. 50° 00' 00" W. a distance of 191.26 feet to a point being the most southerly point on the Sage Subdivision;
 thence N. 39° 35' 02" W. a distance of 200.23 feet to a point being the westerly corner of Lot 24, Sage Subdivision;
 thence S. 47° 33' 00" W. a distance of 185.00 feet to the point of beginning; said tract containing 16.12 acres more or less.
